#### Calling people to discipleship

##### 1. The calling of disciples

Luke 4:31-31 The healing of Peter's mother in law at Peter's house

Luke 5:1-11 The calling of Peter

Luke 5:27-28 The calling of Levi

Luke 5:29-39 The party at Levi's house (new wineskin)

→ the call to follow is central...

##### 2. A formed group of disciples

Luke 6:1 Jesus has a group of 'disciples'

Luke 6:12-49

- Jesus appoints the 12 (12-16)
- and then teaches his disciples (17-49)

Luke 8:9-21

- The disciples alone receive explanations of Jesus teaching
- The disciples alone are relational insiders (not his own family)

Luke 7:11-17, 7:40-56

- The disciples experience the miraculous

Luke 9:28-36

- Jesus has an inner circle

Luke 11:1-4

- They are taught to pray

##### 3. The disciples are sent out

Luke 9:1-11, 10:1-12

- The disciples are sent out to 'do'

#### 4. The disciples are 'sent'

Luke 24:47-53

- Witnesses
- Sent ('apostolos')
- Blessed (// Genesis 1)
- Worshippers

This seems to be Jesus model of leadership (Tim Keel):

Being	Doing
Knowing	Sending

The mission of Jesus may have been to institute the kingdom of God and overcome the evil one – but he was not solely focussed on this. If anything his kingdom strategy seems to be calling and building a community that would serve and build the kingdom of God. He gives the kingdom to this community.

- Jesus is a community builder (a new Israel)
- They are to pass on what he passed on to them
- Success is having successors
