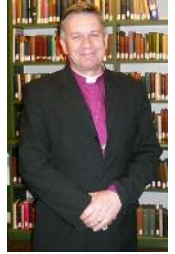

# ARCHBISHOP SIR DAVID MOXON'S VISIT TO ALL SAINTS

On the weekend of the 10th and 11th of August we have Archbishop Sir David Moxon visiting. Whilst he is here we are having a couple of events that are open to everyone to join in with.

Archbishop Sir David Moxon was born and brought up in Palmerston North and All Saint's is his home parish. Following university study, he committed his life to the service of God and others, both in New Zealand and throughout the world. This included many years as the Bishop of Waikato, Archbishop of the New Zealand Dioceses and, more recently, as the Archbishop of Canterbury's Representative to the Holy See, and Director of the Anglican Centre in Rome. In this latter position he was very influential in coordinating Anglican, Roman Catholic and other groups in the fight against human trafficking and modern slavery.
