EMMAUS TERM FOUR COURSES



Enrollments are now open for the following courses:

Radical Living in a World of Big Issues with Mick Duncan. How do we as Christ-followers respond and live in this world? This course will consider how we can do the radical-ordinary with each of these big issues. Runs each Tuesday from 20 October - 24 November, 7.30 - 9.30pm.

Te Rongopai - Revivals in Aotearoa's History with Chris Saunders. This course will include some of the significant revivals in New Zealand with a special emphasis on what has been described as New Zealand's greatest revival. Runs each Tuesday from 20 October - 24 November, 7.30 - 9.30pm.

Understanding the Bible - The New Testament with Pauline Simonsen and Nigel Dixon. The course fills out the historical, cultural and religious world of the NT, and explains the different types of writing in the NT, so that participants will gain a clearer understanding of the background, content and purpose of each book. Runs each Thursday from 15 October - 26 November, 9.30 - 12.30am.
